


Officially called the "Palestinian Sunbird" and popularly called "Palestinian Tamir" and "Abu Al-Zohour", the importance of the bird lies in its name being historically linked to Palestine, and its transformation into a national symbol. It was first discovered and observed in Palestine in 1865, which is the evidence adopted by the "International Council for the Protection of Birds". The "Palestinian Sunbird" is considered a year-round resident bird in the Palestinian territories.

this design beautifully conveys a profound message through a powerful symbol: the Palestine Sunbird soaring freely.


The bird, small in size, mirrors the spirit of Gaza—an area that, despite its small size, has left an immense impact on the world. Just as the sunbird clings to its identity and roots, refusing displacement, Gaza stands as a symbol of resilience and steadfastness, preserving its essence against all odds.

The inclusion of the longitude and latitude of Gaza reinforces the message, emphasizing that this land, no matter how small on the map, remains a center of spirit, strength, and inspiration— much like the little bird that carries a big story on its wings.

Despite the Israeli occupation and the associated destruction of natural areas, grassroots organizations and NGOs in the West Bank and the Gaza Strip as well as the EQA have succeeded in identifying and protecting natural sites and their creatures. Thus, Palestine's national bird, the Palestinian sunbird (Cinnyris osea), and the national flower, the Faqqua iris (Iris haynei) are now considered to be intrinsic symbols of the State of Palestine.
